

Privacy Statement

The SU-CCC (Swiss-Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and Cooperation) is committed to protecting your personal data and processes it in accordance with applicable data protection legislation, including the GDPR where applicable. Appropriate technical and organisational measures are implemented by the SU-CCC and its service providers.

Information We Collect and Use

When you browse our website, we do not seek to identify you. However, we may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide, including your name, email address, telephone number, organisation and any information submitted through our forms.

We process this information to:

- Respond to your enquiries and requests;
- Manage memberships and provide requested services;
- Process registrations for events, seminars and other activities;
- Send newsletters, updates and relevant communications when you have opted to receive them;
- Inform you or your organisation about SU-CCC activities and services in which you have shown an interest.

Providing personal information is voluntary, but we may be unable to fulfil your request without the necessary data.

Sharing of Information

The SU-CCC does not sell, trade or rent personal data. Information may be shared only:

- When required by law, a competent authority or a court order;
- With trusted service providers or business partners assisting us with website operations, data systems, hosting, storage or service delivery.

These providers process personal data solely on behalf of the SU-CCC, according to our instructions, and must maintain its confidentiality.

Google reCAPTCHA

We use Google reCAPTCHA to protect our website against spam and automated abuse. This service may collect technical information, including your IP address, browser data and user agent. Such processing is subject to [Google's Privacy Policy](#) and Terms of Service.

Data Security

We apply reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal data against unauthorised access, disclosure, alteration, loss or destruction. Nevertheless, no transmission of information over the internet can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

Your Rights
